Discipline Policy

Simple rules are explained to the class with periodic reminders. Any child who does not follow a rule will be approached and asked if the choice made was a good choice or a bad choice. Through communication and simple language, students are coached to make good choices and to say "sorry" for bad choices. We believe in forgiveness and a chance to try again to do the right thing in all situations. This is a learning process that is used throughout the school year.

A child may need several reminders throughout the day. If the child has been reminded 3 times for the same occurrence in the same day, he/she will receive an oral warning stating the 4th time will result in a time out. Time out for a child is 3-5 minutes while the child is sitting quietly. The teacher will clearly explain why the child need to have time out. The child will sit in a chair, in the classroom, away from other students. After the time out, the occurrence will be processed with the child in hopes for better choices and changed behavior.

If a child continues to misbehave, be disruptive or at any time cause or threaten to cause harm to another person, classroom property or to himself/herself, the parents will be called for a conference. Suggestions will be made by parents and the teacher on how to improve this behavior. If improvement is not forthcoming, the child will be dismissed from the program at Immanuel Lutheran Preschool.
